Whether or not you choose adoption for your baby:


- We will help you talk about the options available to you

If you are pregnant and struggling with a drug addiction, a methadone program can help you stop using those drugs. It is safe for the baby, keeps you free of withdrawal, and gives you a chance to take care of yourself and your unborn child.



Adoption is beneficial for many reasons:

1. Adoption is not “giving up” your baby. **Most adoptions today are open**, which means you can continue to have contact with the adoptive family as your child grows. This allows you to seek treatment for your addiction and give your baby the opportunity to thrive with a family.
2. Although you may believe the opposite is true, there are many **waiting adoptive families who are ready** and prepared to parent a baby who has been exposed to drugs.
3. Adoption is a choice that you make for your baby that shows you are aware of your challenges with addiction. It is important to know that many doctors or hospitals might test you (and/or your baby) for substances. **Testing positive can trigger an investigation with Child Protective Services** that might complicate custody of your baby. Adoption Choices of Florida will help to ensure that plans for you and your baby are established before you give birth.
